Local Law No. 2 of the year 2000

A local law entitled "Village of East Nassau Local Speed Limit Law"

Be it enacted by the _____ Board of Trustees _____ of the

Village of East Nassau as follows:

**VILLAGE OF EAST NASSAU
LOCAL SPEED LIMIT LAW**

Article I

Authority, Policy, Title, Effective Date

Section 1. Authority.

Pursuant to Article 39, section 1643 of the New York State Vehicle & Traffic Law, the Village Law and the Municipal Home Rule Law, the Board of Trustees is authorized and empowered to establish maximum speed limits at which vehicles may proceed within the municipal boundaries of the Village of East Nassau.

Section 2. Adoption of Law and Title.

By authority of Article 39, section 1643 of the New York State Vehicle & Traffic Law, the Village Law and the Municipal Home Rule Law, this law was adopted on _____, 2000. This local law shall be entitled and known as the "Village of East Nassau Local Speed Limit Law."

Section 3. Effective Date.

This local law shall be effective on _____, 2000 [or upon the filing of same with the Secretary of State of the State of New York]. This local law shall supersede, within the municipal boundaries of the Village of East Nassau, all prior speed limits previously established and/or effective on or along the Village roads, streets and/or highways within the boundaries of the Village of East Nassau.

Section 4. Declaration of Policy.

It is hereby declared to be the policy of the Board of Trustees of the Village of East Nassau to further the safety of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on and along Village roads, streets and highways to the maximum extent practicable and as allowed by law. This means, among other things, that vehicular traffic on and along Village roads, streets and highways should proceed at a safe speed appropriate for the rural character of the Village of East Nassau and its streets, roads and/o highways.

**Article II
Procedure In Filing Subdivision Applications**

Section 1. Establishment of Maximum Speed Limit

It is hereby established that the maximum speed limit at which any and all vehicles may proceed on or along any Village street, road and/or highway located within the municipal boundaries of the Village of East Nassau is thirty (30) miles per hour. The Village streets, roads and/or highways to which this maximum speed limit shall apply include the following: Smith Hill Road, Gardner Hill Road, Murdoch Road, Town Garage Road, Greenmanhill Road, Hayes Road, Woodard Road, Tsatsawassa Lake Road, Bath Township Road, Tayer Road, and Webster Hill Road.

Section 2. Enforcement

The thirty (30) mile per hour speed limit established in this local law shall be enforced by the appropriate law enforcement officers and agencies as any other speed limit maximum.

**Article III
Severability**

Should any section or provision of the regulations contained herein or as amended hereafter be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the regulations as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.
