

Resolution of the Board of Trustee of Village of East Nassau
Introductory Local Law No. 2 of 2019

At the regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of East Nassau (the "Village Board") held on September 11, 2019, the following Resolution was presented:

Whereas, the Village of East Nassau has an established policy to further safety for pedestrians and vehicles traveling on highways and roads and visiting Village parks and properties within the Village to the maximum extent practicable and as allowed by law; and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees has noted that the Village does not have a law requiring notice of defects with respect to the unsafe condition of any Village roads and properties; and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees believes the implementation of a notice of defect requirement in the Village will enhance the Village's ability to remedy dangerous conditions on all properties under the management and care of Village personnel in an expeditious and safe manner; and

Whereas, the Village Mayor has authorized the Village attorney to prepare a proposed local law that would establish a notice of defect requirement and the Village Board has reviewed the proposed local law that was prepared and that is subject to this resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Village Board finds that the implementation of a notice of defect requirement in the Village will enhance the Village's ability to remedy dangerous conditions on all properties under the management and care of Village personnel in an expeditious and safe manner. As such, the Village Board hereby introduces and proposes for adoption introductory Local Law No. 2 of 2019 of the Village of East Nassau which would establish a notice of defect requirement with respect to any unsafe or dangerous condition on any Village road or property as defined in said law.
2. The Village Board determines that the adoption of the proposed Local Law is an action that is not subject to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) since it is a Type II action.
3. The Village Board hereby schedules a public hearing for the proposed Introductory Local Law No. 2 of 2019, to be held at the Hoag's Corners Ambulance Building, located on Town Garage Road, on October 9, 2019, at 6:45 p.m.

4. The Village Board hereby orders that notice of the public hearing be posted at the Village Office, on the Village website, and published at least once in the Village's official newspaper a minimum of 5 days before the scheduled hearing date.

Upon motion made by Mayor Acquario , seconded by Trustee Root, the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of East Nassau on September 11, 2019 by vote of a majority of its members as follows:
