

**Resolution of the Village Board of the Village of East Nassau
Adoption of Local Law No. 1 of 2022**

At a regular monthly meeting of the Village Board of Village of East Nassau, duly held on the 14th day of December 2022, the following Resolution was presented:

WHEREAS, the Village Board has been informed that the New York State Department of State has made numerous amendments to the Uniform Code for buildings which municipalities must implement through code administration and enforcement; and

WHEREAS, it is the Village Board's understanding that the Department of State is requiring municipalities to update their local laws that authorize local Code enforcement to be consistent with the Department of State's Code amendments and model enforcement law before December 30, 2022;

WHEREAS, the Village attorney has advised that it is best to adopt the latest version of the Department of State model code enforcement law tailored to the Village of East Nassau rather than to amend the Village's existing code enforcement law which was adopted in 2006; and

WHEREAS, the counsel has reviewed and prepared the Department of State model law as a proposed Village Local Law (introductory Local Law No. 1 of 2022); and

WHEREAS, that draft law has been reviewed and discussed by the Village Board at a workshop meeting of the Village Board and changes were made accordingly;

WHEREAS, the public hearing on proposed Local Law No. 1 of 2022 was duly held on December 13, 2022 and, after providing the public with an opportunity to make comments on said Law, the hearing was closed by the Village Board; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board is prepared to take action on the proposed law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The public hearing on proposed Local Law No. 1 of 2022 has been duly held and closed and those who wished to be heard regarding said proposed law had a full and fair opportunity to be heard.
2. The Village Board has determined that the adoption of the proposed Local Law is a Type 2 action under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) and no SEQRA review is required.
3. The Village Board hereby adopts Local Law No. 1 of 2022 of the Village of East Nassau, entitled "The Village of East Nassau Code Administration and Enforcement Law," which replaces Local Law No. 2 of 2006 in its entirety.

4. The Village Board hereby directs that the Village Clerk prepare said Law for filing and that it be filed with the Office of the Secretary of State.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
