LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2007

A local law entitled “Technical Amendment to Flood Damage Prevention Law of 2007 of the Village of East Nassau”

A local law for Flood Damage Prevention as authorized by the New York State Constitution, Article IX, Section 2, and Environmental Conservation Law, Article 36

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of East Nassau as follows:

Section 1.0

Purpose

It is the purpose of this local law to amend Local Law No. 1 of 2007 of the Village of East Nassau, entitled “Flood Damage Prevention Law of 2007 of the Village of East Nassau”, to provide for the reference dates of the maps and reports referenced in said law so that the Village’s participation in the National Flood Insurance Program will be fully approved. Subsequent to the adoption of the aforesaid Local Law No. 1 of 2006, the Village received word that said Local Law would not be sufficient to make the Village eligible for participation in the National Flood Insurance Program due to the lack of date references to the maps and reports references in Section 3.2 of said Law. Hence the need for a technical amendment to Local Law No. 1 of 2007 to add the map reference dates which were inadvertently omitted.

SECTION 2.0

Amendment

Section 30, entitled “General Provisions” of Local Law No. 1 of 2007 of the Village of East Nassau, entitled “Flood Damage Prevention Law of 2007 of the Village of East Nassau”, is hereby amended by adding reference dates t the maps and reports referenced in subsection 3.2 of Section 3.0 so that subsection 3.2 of Section 3.0 of said Local Law No. 1 of 2007 is to read as follows:

3.2 BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD

The areas of special flood hazard are identified and defined on the following documents prepared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency:

- (1) Portions of Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) panels, for the Town of Nassau, Rensselaer County, which contain lands within the jurisdiction of the Village of East Nassau including Map Index Number 361155 dated September 5, 1984 and panel numbers 11A, 13A, 21A, and 23A.
- (2) Portions of a scientific and engineering report entitled "Flood Insurance Study, Town of Nassau, New York, Rensselaer County" dated March 5, 1984.
- (3) Portions of Flood Boundary and Floodway Map panels, for the Town of Nassau, Rensselaer County, which contain lands within the jurisdiction of the Village of East Nassau, including Map Index Number 361155 dated September 5, 1984 and panel numbers 11, 13, 21, and 23.

The above documents are hereby adopted and declared to be a part of this Local Law. The Flood Insurance Study and/or maps are on file at the Village Offices located at 64 NYS Route 66, East Nassau, New York 12062.

Section 3.0 Effective Date:

This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
