

Resolution of the Village Board of the Village of East Nassau Introductory Local Law No. 1 of 2022

At a regular monthly meeting of the Village Board of Village of East Nassau, duly held on the 9th day of November, 2022, the following Resolution was presented:

WHEREAS, the Village Board has been informed that the New York State Department of State has made numerous amendments to the Uniform Code for buildings which municipalities must implement through code administration and enforcement; and

WHEREAS, it is the Village Board's understanding that the Department of State is requiring municipalities to update their local laws that authorize local Code enforcement to be consistent with the Department of State's Code amendments and model enforcement law before December 30, 2022;

WHEREAS, the Village attorney has advised that it is best to adopt the latest version of the Department of State model code enforcement law tailored to the Village of East Nassau rather than to amend the Village's existing code enforcement law which was adopted in 2006; and

WHEREAS, the counsel has reviewed and prepared the Department of State model law as a proposed Village Local Law (introductory Local Law No. 1 of 2022); and

WHEREAS, that draft law has been reviewed and discussed by the Village Board at a workshop meeting of the Village Board and changes have been made accordingly;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Village Board hereby introduces and proposes for adoption introductory Local Law No. 1 of 2022 of the Village of East Nassau which is based on the Department of State model law for Code administration and enforcement and if adopted would repeal and replace Local Law No. 2 of 2006 which currently provides the Village's authority for its Code administration and enforcement office and program.
2. The Village Board determines that the adoption of the proposed Local Law is an action that is identified as a Type II action under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) as local legislation involving continuing agency administration, and, as such, further environmental review is not required.
3. The Village Board hereby schedules a public hearing for the proposed Local Law No. 1 of 2022, to be held at the Village meeting room at the Hoag's Corners Ambulance Building, on December 14, 2022, commencing at 6:45 p.m.

4. The Village Board hereby orders that notice of the public hearing be posted at the Village offices, on the Village website, and published at least once in the Village's official newspaper a minimum of 5 days before the scheduled hearing date.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

Upon motion made by Mayor Acquario , seconded by Trustee Jeffrey Root, the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted by the Village Board of the Village of East Nassau on November 9, 2022 by vote of a majority of its members as follows:
